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## Notes for Contributors

See 'Publication Guidelines', inside front cover. Contributors who experience difficulties may submit TWO copies of papers, with author details removed, but supplied on a separate page (with postal and e-mail addresses, and telephone number). We also want position, department or unit in which employed, university/institution information on this separate sheet.

An electronic version through OJS is preferable for first submission, and required for final copy.

Articles should preferably be less than 8,000 words, but longer articles may be submitted. Brief abstracts are required, to accompany the submission.

It is essential that submissions follow the style format employed in the most recent issue of the journal. This is especially the case with references and notes. Also consult the website ([www.transformation.ukzn.ac.za](http://www.transformation.ukzn.ac.za)).

While we recognise that some references (such as to archival material) are more appropriately located in the note format, these are to be seen as exceptions. Copies that do not approximate the style requirements will be returned to authors for resubmission.
